Job Description:

Specific Responsibilities:

- Chairs or participates on the Board Membership Committee.
- Prepares periodic reports, including current membership figures (increases/decreases/renewals) to the Board prior to each biannual Board meeting and upon request.
- Oversees gathering and distribution of information on the TSA Website for all information that
 goes to members, textile-related conferences and symposia, alerts Board members and membersat-large through *Newsletter* and Website, and coordinates the delivery of TSA brochures or flyers to
 those attending so they can be distributed.
- Works with President to develop fundraising initiatives for members.
- Periodically oversees the development of TSA member surveys to ascertain member needs and interests to further the Society's.
